



## **NJ HOBY 2010 Junior Staff Application Information**

Dear NJ HOBY Alumni,

The 2010 NJ HOBY seminar is scheduled for June 4-6, 2010 at Monmouth University. This date is fast approaching and it's time to choose an **OUTSTANDING** group of Junior Staff members! This year, we will be accepting approximately 35 enthusiastic alumni to make up this important group of volunteers. As HOBY alumni, you have already proven that you are valuable leaders and now it's time to pass on your positive HOBY experience to a new group of ambassadors!

This year, the Junior Staff will be split into 3 sections:

### **1. Operations (Under 21 years old):**

- Will assist with daily operational aspects of seminar and work directly with the Director of Operations & Director of Facilities.

### **2. Team Alumni (High school juniors and seniors):**

- Will engage the ambassadors in cheering and team building activities throughout the weekend while maintaining a positive high-energy environment.

### **3. Junior Facilitators (College students under 21 years old):**

- Will shadow a Facilitator and assigned group throughout the seminar, working closely with Director of Facilitators to help the program run smoothly.

### **Requirements for Application Submission**

All Junior Staff members are required to be present for the entire seminar weekend from Thursday evening, June 3<sup>rd</sup> through Sunday afternoon, June 6<sup>th</sup>. There are absolutely **NO** exceptions to this rule, so if you are unable to make this commitment, please do not submit an application.

All Junior Staff members will be required to cover the cost of their attendance for the weekend at the seminar. This fee is **\$350** which covers your room and board for Thursday through Sunday. In addition, the entire Junior Staff will be working together to fundraise an additional **\$7500** for the seminar. These funds will be in the form of cash donations, gift cards, and gifts-in-kind (snacks, office supplies and other useful donations). There are lots of ways you can raise money and you will be working with your fellow HOBY Alumni, so get creative! Please note: these funds will be due no later than May 15, 2010. Do **not** mail in **any** money with your application.

To be selected as a Junior Staff member, you must fill out the enclosed application. In addition, a student from your high school must be registered for the seminar by February 26, 2010. If you have not done so already, please make sure you've logged in your Leadership for Service hours at [www.hoby.org](http://www.hoby.org). You must show significant progress towards (or completion of) your commitment to 100 hours of community service.

We must receive your application by mail. Applications must be postmarked by February 26, 2010.
